Subject: 90-Day Findings on Petitions to List the Yellowstone National Park Bison, Great Basin Silverspot, Narrow-Foot Hygrotus Diving Beetle, and Scott Riffle Beetle as Threatened or Endangered under the Endangered Species Act

Attached is the subject package for your review. We find that the petitions (two) to list the Yellowstone National Park bison do not present substantial information that the petitioned action may be warranted and we recommend a not substantial finding on the petitions. In addition, we find that the petitions to list the Great Basin silverspot, Narrow-Foot Hygrotus diving beetle, and Scott riffle beetle present substantial information that the petitioned actions may be warranted and we recommend substantial findings on these petitions.
