I would ask that Bear Canyon, Big Pryor and the Punch Bowl areas be managed as recommended wilderness as outlined in Alternative D of your CGNF Draft Plan, and expansion of the existing recommended wilderness area of Lost Water Canyon to 13,000 acres. In the Lionhead (Henry's Lake Mountains) I would ask that the current boundaries of the recommended wilderness be kept, managed to allow foot and stock travel only.
