I am a bird and wildlife watcher. I would like to have ecosystems preserved for their benefit. That would mean not allowing mountain biking in recommended wilderness, nor motorized access, so that the areas might someday become Wilderness Areas.

From near where I live I can view the Crazy Mountains, the Beartooth Mountains and Pryor Mountains. I would hope the Crazy Mountains will be managed as recommended Wilderness, with no mechanized or motorized travel.

The Pryor Mountains can be seen from where I live. I would ask that Bear Canyon, Big Pryor and the Pranch Bowl areas be managed as recommended Wilderness as outlined in Alternative D of year 2017 Draft Plan, and expansion of the existing recommended Wilderness Area of Lost Water Canyon to 13,000 acres.

In the Lionhead (Henry's Lake Mountains)
I would ask that the current boundaries
of the recommended Wilderness be kept,
managed to allow foot and stock travel
only.

Forest and our precious wildlands. Thank
you, too, for conducting the review of plans
for management and for considering
my requests.
