Please implement the Gallatin Forest Partnership. This collaborative approach is a model for how diverse interests can reach agreement for managing our public lands.

Please protect the Crazy Mountains to preserve Wilderness values and work with the Crow to protect this incredible landscape. This small range still feels isolated and is one of the most important ranges where I go to seek solitude. The importance of this historic range could not be more apt for Recommended Wilderness.

Please maintain the current recommended Wilderness in the Lionhead, and manage all recommended Wilderness in the Forest just like designated Wilderness. Primitive travel only. No mechanized or motorized use.

In the eastern half of the forest: Please protect Lost Water, Big Pryor, Punch Bowl, and Bear Canyon as recommended Wilderness. Retain recommended Wilderness currently designated as such in the Absaroka Beartooth area, and add in Dome Mountain, Emigrant Peak, Chico Peak, Woodbine, East Rosebud to Stillwater, and Red Lodge Creek.

Finally, in the Ashland district, please manage the Tongue River Breaks, King Mountain, and Cook Mountain as recommended Wilderness.

I appreciate your efforts throughout this planning process and look forward to results that protect the wild character of these world-class public lands. There's nothing quite like the CGNF. It's a place I've built my life around and with increased population we need to be sure this forest plan keeps this part of Montana as Wild as possible.
