Montana's landscapes are some of the spectacular on our continent. I have vacationed in the Glacier National Park area and simply loved it. Consequently, I urge you to protect the Crazy Mountains to preserve their outstanding wilderness values and manage the area in close consultation with the Crow Nation, protect the following roadless areas in the Pryor Mountains as recommended Wilderness: Lost Water, Big Pryor, Punch Bowl, and Bear Canyon.

I urge the implementation of the Gallatin Forest Partnership agreement by maintaining the boundaries of the current recommended Wilderness in the Lionhead. I urge protecting the following roadless areas surrounding the Absaroka-Beartooth Wilderness as recommended Wilderness: Line Creek Plateau, Red Lodge Creek-Hellroaring Plateau, North Fork, Strawberry Creek, Chico Peak, Emigrant Peak, and Dome Mountain.

I urge you to manage the Tongue River Breaks, King Mountain, and Cook Mountain in the Ashland district as non-motorized hiking-and-riding areas, and expressly prohibit mountain bikes, since the landscape is simply not suitable for this use.

I urge managing the recommended Wilderness just like designated Wilderness, allowing only foot and horse travel in recommended Wilderness and not allowing any mechanized or motorized use.
